History of OAO

- 2009 IYA2009 reached more than 815
 million people in 148 countries -- the IAU
 realized the importance of central
 coordination of outreach activities.
- 2012 NAOJ signed the agreement with IAU to create the IAU Office for Astronomy Outreach (OAO).
- 2017 The IAU and NAOJ further extend the agreement of the OAO office to 2021.




0) From the Editors








IAU Strategic Goals 2020-2030
